 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must be able to serve 20 years of active, commissioned service before 62nd birthday</li> <li>• Graduate of ABA-Approved Law School</li> <li>• U.S. Citizen</li> <li>• Medically and Physically qualified</li> <li>• Security Clearance (not required at application)</li> <li>• Admitted to the bar (and be a member in good standing) of either a federal court or the highest court of any state in the United States or the District of Columbia (not required at application)</li> <li>• Be of good moral character</li> </ul>	<p><a href="http://www.jagcnet.army.mil/jaro">http://www.jagcnet.army.mil/jaro</a></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applicant applies and interviews with FSO by 1 November</li> <li>• Medical exams &amp; security clearance investigations are initiated after acceptance</li> </ul>	<p>Offers made approximately 2-4 weeks after Fall selection board (usually meets first week of December).</p> <p>Applicants start in soonest available class after meeting all accession requirements. <b>Coast Guard JAG Corps</b>				
 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Commissioned to active duty after 21st birthday but before 41st birthday</li> <li>• U.S. citizen and pass security clearance requirements</li> <li>• Be a graduate of, or a third-year law student in, an ABA-accredited law school</li> <li>• Admitted to the bar (and be a member in good standing) of either a federal court or the highest court of any state in the United States or the District of Columbia</li> <li>• Must meet physical qualifications in Coast Guard guidance</li> <li>• Have less than 10 years of non-Coast Guard active duty military service</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Interview with a three person panel, which includes at least one Judge Advocate and two other CG officers</li> <li>• Forms located on <a href="http://www.gocoastguard.com">www.gocoastguard.com</a> or call local recruiter</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Two deadlines in a fiscal year -- approximately at the end of Aug and in middle of Feb</li> <li>• Qualified packages received after positions are filled will be held over until the next fiscal year</li> <li>• Eligible to submit during 3rd year of law school</li> </ul>	<p>Selection results are released approximately 2-4 weeks after the selection board meets.
