Re: Fourth/Final 2022 Board Report for NALP's Law School Career Chiefs Interest Group

With the significant "employed by" reporting date of March 15 on the horizon, Alicia and Mary Beth met with the group in February to talk about required Employment Outcomes Reporting to the ABA. At the meeting we shared common themes, helpful tips, unfortunate frustrations, and ultimate solutions for Class of 2021 reporting.

Our next and final meeting for academic year 2021-22 is slated for the end of March (the 24th) and the topic we plan to cover is "Leading (and Remaining Nimble) in Our New Normal." There we will host breakout rooms where law school chief officers will discuss how to keep students engaged, managing a hybrid staff, and preventing burnout in 2022. This should be a helpful follow up to our first meeting as new officers in July called "Re-open, Re-emerge, Re-entry! What we learned in 2020 & best practices for students and staff." We determined to not host an April meeting, and instead we look forward to re-connecting at our group meeting and member reception in New Orleans at the AEC!

Format-wise we continued to use smaller breakout rooms (5-7 rooms of no more than ten people per room, depending on participation that day) and reporting back to the full group on the stated topics.

 - b. How to counsel students
- Counseling Non-JD Law Students (LL.M. and MLS Students)

 - b. Effect on JD Counseling/Employment
- Succession Planning
