

## NALP BOARD LIAISON REPORT: PLANC (Feb. 2021)

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**Report any meetings, webinars, calls or conferences with organizations you have attended in the last 3 months/ Report any notable information or project of interest to NALP/NALP members:**

I attended PLANC's March 6 Board Meeting. Of note:

- AccessLex recently launched an online external scholarship database for law school applicants. Over 800 scholarships have already been identified.
- CLEO has moved all of its programming online, extending its reach across the U.S., as opposed to being limited to in-person regional events.
- LSAC is now running monthly, online trainings and seminars for students, law school admissions officers and pre-law advisers.
- PLANC continues to work on creating a community college advising task force to help identify for PLANC community college pre-law adviser specific needs and related resources.
- PLANC is working on new guidelines for creating strategic partnerships with additional organizations.
- With PLANC's quadrennial conference pushed to 2024, the organization is working on developing additional online programming to engage with membership during the gap.

**Report any goals suggested for the next year:**

I have been talking with a WAPLA member about organizing regional online panel programming to help identify for pre-law advisers ways they can best assist pre-law students prepare in advance for the law school job search, *e.g.*, soft skills development, practice area exploration, networking, job shadowing and the like. Related programming could involve pre-law advisers advising law school career services professionals on areas of support incoming law students may need/knowledge gaps to address.
