RE: PROPOSED CHANGES TO PARTS I-IV OF NALP'S
PRINCIPLES AND STANDARDS

Over the past four years, the Recruitment Practices Advisory Group (previously the Recruitment Practices Committee) has reviewed Parts I-IV of NALP's Principles for Law Placement and Recruitment Activities. In so doing, the Advisory Group has made a number of suggested changes to conform language usage, to reorganize certain sections, and to reflect current recruitment practices.

NALP's Board of Directors and the Recruitment Practices Advisory Group recommend adopting these changes to Parts I-IV of NALP's Principles and Standards.
